INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS AUSTRALIA WELCOMES RACHEL HOLTHOUSE AS NEW CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS VICTORIA

Independent Schools Australia (ISA) congratulates Rachel Holthouse on her appointment as the new Chief Executive of Independent Schools Victoria (ISV).

ISA's CEO, Graham Catt, commended ISV on the appointment, highlighting Ms. Holthouse's background in leadership, education, advocacy and strategy.

Ms. Holthouse will officially assume her new role on 29 July.
